ACCOMMODATIONS

For active duty military/DoD personnel using Navy Gateway Inns & Suites (NGIS – formerly BOQ/CBH)

The location for NGIS check-in is Building #1312. There is parking available while you check in. NGIS telephone numbers are: (401) 841-7900/DSN 841-7900.

For active duty military and DoD personnel traveling on government orders

If you need a non-availability statement, you must visit the NGIS office located in Building #1312 to have your orders endorsed and a non-availability number issued.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Due to limited parking at the Naval War College, trolley transportation will be provided from the conference hotel to the Naval War College in the morning, and back to the hotel in the evening. Conference attendees staying at other area accommodations may use our transportation but must arrive at the Viking Hotel prior to trolley departure (transportation schedules are included in the agenda).

WEATHER

Spring weather in Newport is usually pleasant with mild days and cool evenings; however, wide temperature swings are not uncommon. It is recommended that you check an [on-line weather service](#) prior to travel (for reference, the Newport, RI zip code is 02840).

TRAVEL TO NEWPORT

Commercial Air Most major carriers and commuter lines provide regularly scheduled service to T. F. Green Airport, located just south of Providence, Rhode Island. This is the closest airport to Newport.

Rental Vehicles Most major car rental companies maintain offices at T. F. Green Airport. There are several car rental agencies in Newport, as well. Advance reservations are highly recommended.

Shuttle Vans The Cozy Cab Newport Shuttle provides scheduled service between T. F. Green Airport and the hotels listed in the Accommodations section. Cost is \$25 per person for a one-way trip. If you choose to travel by shuttle, we strongly recommend a shuttle reservation. You may make a reservation with Cozy Cab by calling (401) 846-2500 or (800) 846-1502.

Taxis Taxi fare from T. F. Green Airport to Newport (one way) is approximately \$80. There are currently three taxi companies with access to Naval Station Newport:

- A1 Car & Cab..... (401) 841-0411
- Cozy Cab (401) 846-2500
- Orange Cab (401) 846-1994

Railroad AMTRAK provides direct passenger service to Providence and Kingston (closest to Newport) stations from Washington, Philadelphia, New York, and Boston. There are no rental car outlets at either station; however, taxis will provide service by advance reservation.

Driving Directions Guests traveling to Newport from:

- Points west, including T. F. Green Airport--proceed south down the western side of Narragansett Bay via I-95 to Route 4 (Exit 9 on the left) which will become Route 1. Exit onto Route 138 east and proceed over the Jamestown and Newport Bridges to Newport. (Note: there is a \$4 toll on the Newport Bridge.)
- Points north--proceed south via I-93 to Route 24, then take Route 114 to Newport.
- Points south--proceed via I-95 north to Route 138 east. Follow Route 138 past the University of Rhode Island, head briefly north when Routes 138 and 1 merge, then continue on Route 138 east over the Jamestown and Newport bridges to Newport. (Note: there is a \$4 toll on the Newport Bridge.)
