The editors of /luce.nt/ periodically send out a call for papers. You may, however, submit at any time to editorlucent@usnwc.edu. Below are some guidelines.

- **Academic articles:** We welcome a broad range of topics related to national security, policy, and joint and combined military operations. (≈5000 words)
- **Personal Narrative:** All of us working in the world of national security have witnessed and participated in something worth sharing with our colleagues, and writing a personal narrative is one way to share those experiences. (500 to 1000 words)
- **From the archives:** Introduce a document or article from the archives of a Service War College or professional journal and share your thoughts on its relevance today. (≈500 words)
- **Old and New Review:** Nominate and write a comparative review of two books, articles, films or photos on a related topic but of different eras. (≈ 1000 words)
- **International voices:** An expansion of knowledge and ideas in the global arena isn't complete without an understanding of the views possessed by those with a different cultural perspective. We encourage and desire academic articles and personal narrative submissions from International Officers and security professionals.

Submissions should be of the length described in the categories above, though other lengths may be considered. Papers should be submitted as .doc or .rtf files. Chicago style is preferred. Please submit articles to editorlucent@usnwc.edu.
