

STUDENTS

Students detailed to the Naval War College in Newport participate in a ten-month program of academic and strategic development. Depending on the curriculum requirements of each trimester, students are expected to read on average 500 pages per week, write regular papers and take exams. Average student class and study time is 50 to 60 hours per week. The [core curriculum](#) provides the backbone for Joint Professional Military Education (JPME) credit and an accredited Masters of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies. The [electives track](#) supplements the core curriculum, allowing each student to pursue a more specialized area of study and in most cases graduate with an Additional Qualification Designator (AQD – Navy only). Needless to say, it is a rigorous and incredibly rewarding year requiring significant time management skills.

The tour also offers a rare opportunity to spend some time with family. Newport is one of New England's most historic seaports, offering a wide array of extracurricular activities: sailing, music and food festivals, turn of the century mansions and a bustling downtown area, all just minutes from the Naval War College.
